DL-638SI, NEW FORM

The provisions of Act 113 of 2006 goes into effect on September 8th. This Act amends 75 Pa.C.S. § 3327(B.1). The amended subsection will provide that, when a defendant is convicted, adjudicated delinquent, or admitted into a pre-adjudication program for a violation of 75 Pa.C.S. §3327(a) (related to approaching or passing an emergency response area), and the violation resulted in a serious injury to another person, PennDOT shall suspend the defendant's license for 90 days.

As a result, a new MDJS form, DL-638SI, has been created to report the serious injury to PennDOT. In addition, two new entries have been made to the statute file. The new entries are:

75 Pa.C.S. §3327(A1-SI)
75 Pa.C.S. §3327(A2-SI)

Following a conviction (GP, GT) for a violation of either 75 Pa.C.S. § 3327(a)(1) or 75 Pa.C.S. § 3327(a)(2), the Magisterial District Judge will need to determine if a serious injury occurred as a result of the violation. If a determination is made that a serious injury occurred, the extension "-SI" should be added to the subsection field on the Final Charges and Fines screen. When you press enter on the Case Disposition screen, two copies of form DL-638SI will print. Keep one copy in the case file and mail the other copy to the address shown on the bottom of the form.
