F70 – NEW FINE TYPE

Fine type F70 has been added to the MDJS to implement provisions of Act 135 of 2006 relating to gambling laws. This fine type disburses the fine money to the Department of Revenue with an account code COMM-GAMB (Gambling) The fine type is associated with new statute entries under Sections 1512 and 1518 of Title 4. The allocation is:

WARRANT ID

Bench Warrants and Warrants of Arrest will now display the Warrant Id (i.e., tracking number prefaced with "MDJS") on the first page of the warrant. This number is being included in electronic messaging to CLEAN/NCIC, but will also print on the form for the officer who is recording a manual entry into CLEAN.

EDI MESSAGES

The following applies only to magisterial district courts that receive cases through the EDI process.

AOPC has added additional safeguards by checking for transaction conflicts or issues between the time the EDI batch has been processed by AOPC and accepted by the court. As a result, you may receive an additional rejected records error message report with new error messages.

As an example, an edit check is performed when a batch is first processed by AOPC to determine if the electronic case record already exists at the court. Due to the time delays in a court accepting the batch, additional duplication checks and monitoring will now be performed during the accepting of the batch process. If issues are found, an error report will generate at your printer.

AOPC will also be made aware of any errors on this report because an auto-generated email will be created. Should the new report print, most of the errors and reasons for the rejection will be apparent, but if you have any concerns or questions, contact the MDJS Help Desk.
