## **FUGITIVE DECLARATION**

After declaring a defendant a fugitive, four copies of the Fugitive Notice (AOPC 619) will now print. These copies are for the District Justice, Court Administrator, District Attorney, and Court of Common Pleas.

## **SUPPLEMENTAL JUDGMENT FORM**

The Notice of Judgment/Transcript Supplementary Action (AOPC 315C) has been updated. The form now contains a checkbox followed by "Satisfaction was entered for \_\_\_\_\_ on \_\_\_\_\_." The underlying docket number will print on the first blank line and the date that satisfaction was entered will print on the second blank line. The purpose of this information is to show that satisfaction has been recorded since prior to the hearing there was no documentation from the creditor reflecting satisfaction of judgment.

## **POP-UP WINDOW FOR S2 ACCOUNTS**

A pop-up window will now appear on the Final Charge Entry screen after an S2 (School, Library, Tax) account is selected. The purpose of the pop-up window is to confirm your selection of the correct account. It will state the name of the account you selected followed by a question that asks if it is correct.

## **WORK ZONE VIOLATION MESSAGE**

A new warning message appears on the Charge Entry screen if you indicated on the Traffic Citation Entry screen that the offense occurred in an active work zone. The message is simply a reminder for you to double the fine amount on the Charge Entry screen, provided the officer did the same on the citation.

## **NEI DISPOSITION**

The disposition of NEI (Individual Not Found) can now be recorded as a disposition for a Title 75 charge docketed on a criminal court case.

## **WARNING MESSAGE**

Message CSW0100- TWP/BORO/CITY CODE DOES NOT MATCH OFFICER ID displays if an arresting agency's account code does not match the code recorded in the Twp/Boro/City field on the Traffic, Non-Traffic, and Criminal Case Entry screen. This is to alert you to a discrepancy between the municipality code of where the police are organized and the location of the offense. The message has been refined to no longer display if the arresting agency's account code is blank which means the arresting agency is responsible for providing coverage to multiple boroughs or townships. In other words, the message will only display if the arresting agency has an account code and if that account code number differs from what is recorded in the Twp/Boro/City field.

## **MANUAL RECEIPT LOG UPDATED**

A new Initial/Date Entered DJS column has been added next to the Received By column on the Manual Receipt log. In the Initial/Date Entered DJS field on the Manual Receipt log, write your initials and the date you entered the payment into the DJS. Recording your initials and date is important for auditing purposes.
