SUMMARY CASES INVOLVING JUVENILES

Effective May 30th, MDJS improvements were implemented which impact the way summary cases with juvenile defendants are processed. This laser fax highlights the changes completed in the first phase of programming. More changes are planned to improve juvenile case processing in the MDJS.

Case Processing

System edits are now in place in the Juvenile Certification/Truancy Referral option accessed from the Case Status Menu. The system will not allow the use of inappropriate action codes that have caused problems with the case status in the past. Additionally, you are prevented from printing the Impending Notice of Juvenile Certification (AOPC 608C) if a case has Community Service or Alternate Sentencing.

Batch Processing Menu

The Juvenile Actions List now shows TRF in the Copy column if the case contains the Violation of Compulsory Attendance charge and it meets the criteria for a Truancy Referral (AOPC 608B). This improvement allows you to print or cancel a Truancy Referral from outside a case.

The nightly Juvenile Actions Report shows the same cases as the batch processing list. However, for cases charging Violation of Compulsory Attendance, JN will continue to display on the nightly report instead of TRF. Future programming changes are planned to ensure the nightly report matches the batch processing list.
